Skateboarding, skating and other use of this skateboard park is a hazardous recreational activity. No supervision or staffing of the park is provided. Users of this park do so at his or her own risk and may be responsible for injuries and damages.

PARK RULES

- Helmets, elbow, and knee pads must be worn at all times.
- Current County social distancing protocols must be followed:
 - Do not enter the Park if you have COVID-19 Symptoms
 - Always maintain a minimum six-foot distance from others
 - Face coverings required for 3 years of age or older
 - Face coverings required to enter park and while inside the park except while skating/biking
 - Sneeze and cough into a cloth or tissue or, if not available, into your elbow
 - Do not shake hands or engage in any unnecessary physical contact
- The skate park is open for skateboarding and inline skating only.
- Bicycles and scooters are not permitted except during scheduled times posted at the facility.
- No smoking, alcoholic beverages, or drugs are permitted.
- Do not bring food or drink in to the fenced skating area.
- Animals must be kept outside the fenced skating area.
- Graffiti, tagging, or defacing of any kind is not permitted.
- Amplified music is not allowed without a special event permit.
- Adding elements to the park is prohibited.
- No person under the age of 12 may use this skateboard park unless accompanied by and under the supervision at all times of a responsible adult.

Users must obey the park rules at all times. Failure to follow these rules may result in prosecution, fines or exclusion from use of the park (MHMC 12.20.095).
