



Kids' Club Rules and Regulations

Kids' Club Ages: 6 months-9 years

Member Requirements:

All Parent/Guardian must bring a Photo ID and leave it in Kids' Club for the duration.

Parent/Guardian have a 90-minute time limit per child/day.

Parent/Guardian **MUST REMAIN IN THE FACILITY AT ALL TIMES.**

Kids' Club Check-In:

Parent/Guardian must check in at the welcome desk prior to dropping off at Kids' Club where they will obtain a hand stamp.

Parent/Guardian will then check in at Kids' Club, fill out the check-in form entirely and leave a photo id.

Kids' Club Pick Up:

The same Parent/Guardian that dropped off MUST pick up.

Sign out the child and obtain photo id.

Only staff members may open/close the gate.

Non-member/Guest Check In:

Non-members must check in at the welcome desk and pay an \$8/child drop-in fee.

All other check-in and check-out procedures remain the same.

Reason to Call Parent/Guardian:

If the child is inconsolable for more than 10 minutes.

If the child needs a diaper change.

If the child is ill: Shows sign of green runny nose, excessive coughing, rash or fever.

If the child injures themselves or another child.

If the child is not following kids' club rules. (No hitting, running inside, jumping from outside play equipment).

Kids' Club Rules

- No food or drink aside from water inside of Kids' Club (must bring own water bottle).
- No personal toys or electronic devices.
- Parents are limited to 10 minutes in Kids' Club with their child. (to console or comfort).
- If your child is too sick for school, they are too sick for Kids Club.
- Children that are walking must wear shoes and socks at all times. No child will be allowed outside without shoes and socks.
- Our insurance does not allow our staff to baby-sit families involved in programs while they are employed by the CRC/YMCA. Please make it easy for them by respecting this policy.

In the Event Of An Emergency:

In the event of an emergency drill or a real emergency, the children will be escorted out of the Kids' Club door through the playground. For a drill the children will be lined up alongside the side wall outside of the Kids' Club Playground. For a real emergency the children will be escorted to the basketball court in the park.
