ABOUT THE MORGAN HILL SENIOR CENTER

The Morgan Hill Centennial Recreation Senior Center opened in 2006 and has been a vibrant and dynamic hub for older adult services. In June 2016, the City of Morgan Hill earned the Age-Friendly City designation from the World Health Organization. The Senior Center has evolved over the past few years to include other Older Adult Programs and Services and partnerships in the areas of:

- housing
- respect and social inclusion
- transportation
- communication and information
- social participation
- community support and health services

The City went through significant budget reductions in the past and the amount of funding for Senior Services was reduced. In order to maintain Senior Center operations through that time of fiscal difficulties, a new separate group, the Friends of the Morgan Hill Senior Center, was established to support the Senior Center and programs being offered.
