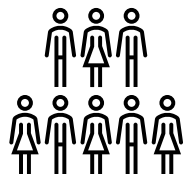

Inclusive Public Engagement in City Decisions

Themes	Key Issues
Desire for Community Involvement	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Challenges such as distance, time, and childcare.• Do not know how to get involved or what issues are being heard.• Hispanic/Latino community members expressed the fear they face of the recent ICE actions nationally.
Barriers to Civic Engagement	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Uncertain how to engage.• Challenges around access to technology, transportation.
Communication and Outreach	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Improve communication between city officials and the community.• Language and technology barriers hinder access to information.• Need to increase visibility, access, and use of the City's website in Spanish.• Unaware of community events.

Pollution Exposure and Air Quality

Themes	Key Issues
Traffic-related Pollution	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Air and noise pollution resulting from heavy traffic.• Improved public transportation and active transportation options.• MoGo or a similar rideshare program.• More trees and green spaces.
Green Spaces and Access	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• More trees and green spaces.• Increase community gardens, wider sidewalks, bike lanes, accessible transportation options for non-drivers, speed management for motorized vehicles, and bus shelters with weather protection.
Eco-friendly Community	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Homes abutting non-compatible uses.• Zero emissions for businesses.• Air filtration or air purifier program for homes.

Promoting Physical Activity

Themes	Key Issues
Community Health and Well-Being	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Hospitals, medical clinics, and mobile dental clinics.• Affordable activities for children and teenagers.• High membership costs to the CRC.• Safe and well-maintained, lit, public spaces.• Expand community events and free recreation, specifically the Splash Pad hours.• Provide information about discounted recreation program costs and translate information to Spanish.
Improvements in Public Facilities and Infrastructure	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Safety enhancements (streetlights, crossings & cycling infrastructure).• Improvements to public transit accessibility.• Closer parks; parks for all abilities and teenagers.• Trails to schools.

Affordable Healthy Food Access

Themes	Key Issues
Affordable and Accessible Healthy Food	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Access to fresh affordable healthy food, particularly for seniors with limited mobility.• Allow permanent fruit stands/produce markets.• Educational nutrition programs.• Expand locations and hours for food banks.
Community Gardens	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Increase community gardens.
Local Food Systems and Infrastructure	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Grocery stores are car-centric.• Allow permanent fruit stands/produce markets.

Safe and Healthy Homes

Themes	Key Issues
Affordable Housing	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Need for more affordable housing.• Displacement.• Low-cost loans for critical home repairs and weatherization.
Community Safety	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Speeding cars feel unsafe to bike or walk.• Flooding.• Transient activity.
Community Well-being	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Education programs.• Water filtration program.• Air filtration or air purifier programs for homes.• Eliminate the use of toxic pesticides.

Increase Overall Health

Themes	Key Issues
Support for Recreation and Physical Activity Programs	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Free exercise programs.• High membership costs to CRC.
Programming for Personal Health and Growth	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Workshops and programs.• Educational materials in Spanish and English on allergies, asthma, overall health, nutrition, and budgeting programs.
Community Health and Well-Being	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Hospitals, medical clinics, and mobile dental clinics.• Expand community events and free recreation.• Discounted recreation programs.• Revise landscaping policies that are asthma friendly.• Impacts of extreme heat.

Public Facilities and Infrastructure

Themes	Key Issues
Support for Recreation and Physical Activity Programs	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Enhance active transportation connectivity to access public amenities and schools. • High membership costs to the Centennial Recreation Center. • Safe and well-maintained, lit, public spaces. • Expand community events and free recreation, specifically the Splash Pad hours.
Stormwater Management and Infrastructure	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Improve stormwater management to avoid flooding.
Improvements in Public Facilities and Infrastructure	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Enhance street and pedestrian infrastructure and safety enhancements. • Improve public transit accessibility. • Closer parks, parks for all abilities, and parks for teenagers. • Trails to schools. • Increase community gardens, wider sidewalks, bike lanes, accessible transportation options for nondrivers, speed management for motorized vehicles, public restrooms at parks, human-scale lighting, and bus shelters with weather protection were suggested. • More benches/seating.
Access to Community Services	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Public park facilities in Opportunity Neighborhoods. • Improve “Safe Routes to Schools”.
